- Year 12 received trials back. Graduation assembly and lunch prep well under way. Would like to ask P&C to again subsidise the cost for staff who attend.
- Sports – Lawn Bowls team have made the state final in Temora two-day event. Numerous place getters and PBs at athletics and cross-country.
- Year 11 student leadership process well under way. All have submitted exceptional portfolios; voting will take place next week. All 20 students have opted for the 'captain' stream meaning that the students who move to the next stage will be interviewed.
- Parent Teacher night – great night discussing student learning and achievement.

- Professional Learning – approx. 20 beginning teachers from across school in the network attended a workshop last week run by Richard Griffith and Blake Leonard. Was very successful.
- Lunch Wednesday trial of 30-minute recess and 30-minute lunch – discussion of support for trial.
- Changes to Monday assembly been very positive, students are being more effectively recognised for their achievements, also introduced a weekly principal award. Keiran has been performing National Anthem a Capella - amazing.
- Performing Arts – Jackson Long has been accepted into the Talent Development Program - Stage 1, run by the Arts Unit. A number of students were part of the boys vocal ensemble with the Arts Unit - Keiran and Marcus Brain, Micah Winton, Ben Webb, Josh Ebrahim and Micah McKay.
